Other important publications include 'Boundaries, bars and barricades: Reconsidering two approaches to crime prevention in the built environment' in the *Journal of Architectural and Planning Research*, and 'Gated neighbourhoods in South Africa: An appropriate urban design approach?' in *Urban Design International*.

Dr Landman has received several awards for academic excellence from the CSIR. Dr Landman is currently on the organising committee for the 2012 Planning Africa Conference and was on the organising committee of a recent urban design seminar hosted by the University of the Witwatersrand and supported by the Urban Design Institute of South Africa (UDISA). She is a member of both UDISA and the South African Planning Institute (SAPI). Dr Landman is a Y1-rated NRF researcher.
