



Dr Killander is Hoof van Navorsing in die Sentrum vir Menseregte van die Fakulteit Regsgeleerdheid. Hy het aan die Universiteit van Pretoria gepromoveer met 'n doktorsale proefskrif oor "The role of the African Peer Review Mechanism in inducing compliance with human rights".

In sy navorsing konsentreer dr Killander op streeksintegrasie en die impak van internasionale wetgewing oor menseregte op nasionale vlak. Sy publikasies sluit 'n boek in – *International law and domestic human rights litigation in Africa* (Pretoria University Law Press, 2010) – en artikels in vooraanstaande vaktydskrifte, boeke en bronne op die Internet, soos byvoorbeeld die *Max Planck Encyclopedia of Public International Law*.

Dr Killander is Hoofredakteur van *African Human Rights Law Reports*, Mederedakteur van die *African Human Rights Law Journal* en redakteur van verslae oor presedentereg in Afrika vir die *Oxford Reports on International Law*. Dr Killander het navorsing gedoen vir die VN en die Afrika-Unie, en as portuurbeoordelaar opgetree vir die uitgewershuis Oxford University Press en Routledge, en vir verskeie akademiese vaktydskrifte. Hy het 'n Y2-gradering van die NNS.

Dr Killander is Head of Research at the Centre for Human Rights in the Faculty of Law. He received his doctorate from the University of Pretoria in 2009 with the thesis: 'The role of the African Peer Review Mechanism in inducing compliance with human rights'.

His research focuses on regional integration and the impact of international human rights law at national level. His publications include *International law and domestic human rights litigation in Africa* (Pretoria University Law Press, 2010) and articles in leading journals, books and online resources such as the *Max Planck Encyclopedia of Public International Law*.

Dr Killander is the Editor-in-Chief of the *African Human Rights Law Reports*, Co-Editor of the *African Human Rights Law Journal*, and Editor of African case law reports for the *Oxford Reports on International Law*. He has conducted research for the United Nations and the African Union and acted as peer reviewer for the Oxford University Press, Routledge and various academic journals. He has a Y2-rating from the NRF.
