



Prof Carstens is Professor en Hoof van die Departement Geesteswetenskaplike Opvoedkunde in die Fakulteit Opvoedkunde. Voor sy hierdie pos beklee het, was sy Adjunkdirekteur van die Eenheid vir Akademiese Geletterdheid. Sy het twee doktorsgrade, die graad DLitt et Phil (Afrikaans) van die Universiteit van Suid-Afrika (Unisa) en 'n DPhil (Linguïstiek) van die Universiteit van Pretoria.

Prof Carstens het 38 artikels in geakkrediteerde vaktydskrifte agter haar naam en het 47 referate by plaaslike en internasionale konferensies gelewer.

Die artikels wat sy as haar invloedrykste bydraes op haar vakgebied beskou, sluit in "Narrow-angled versus wide-angled writing interventions, report on a quasi-experiment" in *Southern African Linguistics and Applied Language Studies*, 29(2):149-165 (2011).

Sy het deur die loop van haar loopbaan op die besture van etlike professionele liggame gedien, onder meer die Linguïstiekvereniging van Suider-Afrika en die African Association for Lexicography (Afrilex). Sedert 2010 is sy lid van die itemhersienningspaneel van die Nasionale Normtoetse (Akademiese Geletterdheid). Sy het 'n C3-gradering van die NNS.

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Prof Carstens is a Professor and Head of the Department of Humanities Education. Before taking up this position she was Deputy Director of the Unit for Academic Literacy. She holds two doctorates: a DLitt et Phil (Afrikaans) from the University of South Africa (Unisa) and a DPhil (Linguistics) from the University of Pretoria.

Prof Carstens has published 38 articles in accredited journals and has presented 47 papers at local and international conferences.

Among the articles she regards to be her most influential, is 'Narrow-angled versus wide-angled writing interventions report on a quasi-experiment' in *Southern African Linguistics and Applied Language Studies*, 29(2):149-165 (2011).

During her career she has served on the executives of a number of professional bodies, including the Linguistics Society of Southern Africa and the African Association for Lexicography (Afrilex). Since 2010 she has been a member of the item review panel for the National Benchmark Tests (Academic Literacy). She has a C3-rating from the NRF.
