



Prof Hofmeyr is 'n filosoof wat in sowel Suid-Afrika as Nederland werksaam is. Nadat sy haar doktorsale proefskrif in Filosofie aan die Radboud Universiteit Nijmegen (RU) in Nederland voltooi het, het sy aan die Jan van Eyck Academie in Maastricht navorsing oor die politieke dimensie van kuns- en kultuurproduksie gedoen. Sy is tans aan die Departement Filosofie van die Universiteit van Pretoria verbonde as Medeprofessor en aan die Departement van Wysgerige Antropologie van die Fakulteit Filosofie, Teologie en Godsdienwetenskap aan die RU as navorsingsgenoot en gasdosent.

Die noemenswaardigste toekenning onder die 18 pryse, beurse en genootskappe wat sy ontvang het, is die Veni-beurs (Innovational Research Incentives Scheme), 'n onderdeel van die Vernieuwingsimpuls, 'n hoogs mededingende navorsingsbeurs vir vier jaar, toegeken deur die Nederlandse Organisasie vir Wetenskaplike Onderzoek (NWO). Die Veni-beurs is geormerk vir jong navorsers wat onder die top tien tot 20 persent van hul portuurgroep in hul studieveld tel. In 2010 het die Universiteit van Pretoria haar ook as 'n Uitnemende Jong Navorsers erken.

Afgesien van haar gepubliseerde DPhil-proefskrif, talle akademiese artikels en hoofstukke in boeke, is prof Hofmeyr Redakteur van twee akademiese boeke: *Radical passivity. Rethinking ethical agency in Levinas* (Springer, 2009) en *The Walmart Phenomenon. Resisting neo-liberal power through art, design, and theory* (Jan van Eyck Academie Press, 2008). Die twee bundels is 'n aanduiding van haar veelsydigheid as filosoof aangesien een 'n gespesialiseerde versameling van essays in die veld van filosofiese etiek is, terwyl die ander een 'n interdisiplinêre bundel bestaande uit akademiese bydraes in die velde van filosofie, sosiale geografie, kuns en ontwerp is.

Prof Hofmeyr is lid van die Nordiese Vereniging van Fenomenologie (Denemarke), die Sentrum vir Psigoanalise en Wysgerige Antropologie (België), die Philosophical Society of Southern Africa en die Nederlands-Afrikaanstalige Wysgerige Genootskap. Prof Hofmeyr het 'n C2-gradering van die NNS.

Prof Hofmeyr is a philosopher working in both South Africa and in the Netherlands. After the completion of her doctoral thesis in Philosophy at the Radboud University Nijmegen (RU) in the Netherlands, she conducted research at the Jan van Eyck Academie in Maastricht on the political dimension of art and cultural production. At present she is affiliated to the Department of Philosophy of the University of Pretoria as Associate Professor as well as to the Department of Philosophical Anthropology in the Faculty of Philosophy, Theology and Religious Science of the RU as Research Fellow and guest lecturer.

The most notable among the 18 prizes, scholarships and fellowships she has received is the Innovational Research Incentives Scheme (Veni), a highly competitive four-year research grant awarded by The Netherlands Organisation for Scientific Research aimed at early-career scholars that rank among the top ten to 20 per cent in their field. In 2010 the University of Pretoria recognised her research excellence by way of an Exceptional Young Researcher's Award.

Apart from her published DPhil thesis, numerous academic articles and book chapters, Prof Hofmeyr edited two scholarly volumes: *Radical Passivity. Rethinking Ethical Agency in Levinas* (Springer, 2009) and *The Walmart Phenomenon. Resisting Neo-liberal Power Through Art, Design, and Theory* (Jan van Eyck Academie Press, 2008). These volumes showcase her philosophical ambidexterity, one is a specialised subject-specific compilation in the field of philosophical ethics, whereas the other is an interdisciplinary volume that include contributions by academics in the fields of philosophy, social geography, art and design.

Prof Hofmeyr is member of the Nordic Society of Phenomenology (Denmark), the Centre for Psychoanalysis and Philosophical Anthropology (Belgium), the Philosophical Society of Southern Africa and the Nederlands-Afrikaanstalig Wijsgerig Genootschap. Prof Hofmeyr has a C2-rating from the NRF.
