



Prof Bradlow beklee die SARCHI-leerstoel in Internasionale Ontwikkelingsreg en Ekonomiese Verhoudings in Afrika in die Fakulteit Regsgeleerdheid van die Universiteit van Pretoria en is Professor in Regsgeleerdheid aan die American University Washington College of Law in Washington, DC. Hy is Voorsitter van die *Roster of Experts* van die onafhanklike hersieningsmeganisme van die Ontwikkelingsbank van Afrika en 'n deskundige lid van die werkgroep belas met natuurprodukte-bedrywe, die omgewing en menseregte van die African Commission on Human and Peoples' Rights. Hy is mederapporteur van die Internasionale Regsgenootskap se studiegroep oor die toerekenbaarheid van internasionale organisasies, lid van die direksie van New Rules for Global Finance en van die uitvoerende raad van die American Society of International Law. Hy dien op die adviesrade van die Financial Regulation and Human Rights Project ('n projek van 'n koalisie van nie-regeringsorganisasies gekoördineer deur die Center of Concern), die *Journal of Law, Social Justice and Global Development*, die *American University International Law Review* en *Sustainable Development Law and Policy*.

Prof Bradlow het onlangs gedien as lid van die hoëvlakpaneel wat deur die Brookings Institution aangestel is om die internasionale Finansiële Stabiliteitsraad (FSB) oor die bestuur van die liggaam te adviseer. Vroeër het hy as Senior Spesiale Genoot deelgeneem aan die werksaamhede van die Legal Aspects of Debt and Financial Management Programme van die United Nations Institute on Training and Research (UNITAR). Hy het ook as lid van die uitvoerende raad van die Internasionale Regsgenootskap se Komitee oor Toerekenbaarheid van Internasionale Organisasies gedien.

Prof Bradlow is the incumbent of the SARCHI (South African Research Chair Initiative) Chair of International Development Law and African Economic Relations in the Faculty of Law at the University of Pretoria, and Professor of Law at the American University Washington College of Law in Washington, DC. He is the Chair of the Roster of Experts for the Independent Review Mechanism at the African Development Bank, and an expert member of the working group on extractive industries, the environment and human rights of the African Commission on Human and Peoples' Rights. He is co-rapporteur of the International Law Association's study group on accountability of international organisations; a member of the board of directors of New Rules for Global Finance and of the executive council of the American Society of International Law. He serves on the advisory boards of the Financial Regulation and Human Rights Project (a project of a coalition of international non-governmental organisations organised by the Centre of Concern), the *Journal of Law, Social Justice and Global Development*, *American University International Law Review*, and *Sustainable Development Law and Policy*.

Prof Bradlow recently served as a member of a high-level panel that was formed by the Brookings Institution to advise the Financial Stability Board (FSB) on its governance. He previously participated as a Senior Special Fellow in the legal aspects of debt and financial management programme of the United Nations Institute on Training and Research (UNITAR). He served as a member of the executive council of the International Law Association's Committee on Accountability of International Organizations.

His recent publications include: *International Financial Institutions and International Law* (co-edited with D Hunter, 2010, Kluwer Press) and *International financial institutions and global legal governance* (co-edited with H Cisse and B Kingsbury, World Bank Legal Review, 2011). A book he co-authored for The World Bank, Law Justice and Development Series, (2002) entitled *Regulatory frameworks for dam safety: A comparative study* has been translated into Chinese, French and Russian. He is a B1-rated NRF researcher.
