



Prof Nieuwenhuis is Medeprofessor in die Departement Onderwysbestuur en -beleidstudie in die Fakulteit Opvoedkunde. Hy het die grade DEd (Rand Afrikaanse Universiteit) en MDiac (Unisa). Hy het sy navorsingsloopbaan in 1979 in die Raad vir Geesteswetenskaplike Navorsing begin.

Prof Nieuwenhuis is die outeur van twee akademiese boeke en het agt hoofstukke tot akademiese boeke bygedra. Hy het meer as 40 tegniese navorsingsverslae opgestel en 15 artikels as outeur of mede-outeur in portuurbeoordeelde vaktydskrifte gepubliseer. Hy het talle referate by opvoedkundige konferensies gelewer. In sy huidige navorsing konsentreer hy op waardes, menseregte en sosiale geregtigheid in die onderwys. As navorsingsmetodoloog het hy opvoedkunde departemente en nagraadse studente opgelei. Sy bydrae tot kwalitatiewe navorsing sluit vyf hoofstukke in boeke oor navorsingsmetodologie in. In 2010 is hy vereer met die Senior Buitengewone Navorsingsmedalje van die Opvoedkondevereniging van Suid-Afrika. Hy was studieleier of promotor vir 19 meesters- en doktorsgrade.

Prof Nieuwenhuis is 'n konsultant vir die Raad vir Hoër Onderwys (CHE) oor die akkreditering van programme vir hoër onderwys. Hy dien op die akkrediteringsliggaam van die Kwaliteitskomitee vir Hoër Onderwys (HEQC) van die Raad vir Hoër Onderwys. Hy is lid van talle opvoedkundige en kulturele organisasies, onder meer die onderwyskommissie van die Suid-Afrikaanse Akademie vir Wetenskap en Kuns, die verwysingsgroep vir die professionele ontwikkeling van onderwysers van die Suid-Afrikaanse Raad vir Opvoeders (SACE), en die Departement van Basiese Opvoeding. Hy is Ondervoorsitter van die Belangegroep vir Onderwysbestuur van die Opvoedkondevereniging van Suid-Afrika (EASA|OVSA). Hy het in 2008 as konsultant vir UNESCO se deskundige konsultatiewe groep vir die omskrywing van basiese onderwys van UNESCO opgetree. Hy het 'n C3-gradering van die NNS.

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Prof Nieuwenhuis is an Associate Professor in the Department of Education Management and Policy Studies in the Faculty of Education. He holds a DEd (Rand Afrikaans University) and MDiac (Unisa). He started his research career in 1979 with the Human Sciences Research Council.

He is the author of two academic books, has contributed eight chapters to academic books, has produced more than 40 technical research reports and as author or co-author, has published 15 articles in refereed academic journals. He has delivered numerous papers at education conferences. His current research focuses on values, human rights and social justice in education. As research methodologist he has trained education departments and postgraduate students. His contribution to qualitative research includes five chapters in books on research methodology. In 2010 he was awarded the Senior Research Medal Extraordinaire of the Education Association of South Africa. He has supervised 19 master's and doctoral students.

Prof Nieuwenhuis is a consultant to the Council on Higher Education regarding the accreditation of higher education programmes. He serves on the Accreditation Committee of the Higher Education Quality Committee of the Council on Higher Education. He is a member of numerous educational and cultural organisations, such as the education commission of the Suid-Afrikaanse Akademie vir Wetenskap en Kuns, the reference group for teacher professional development of the South African Council for Educators (SACE) and the Department of Basic Education. He is Vice-Chairman of the education management interest group of the Education Association of South Africa. He was a consultant to the UNESCO Expert Consultative Group on the Definition of Basic Education (2008). He has a C3-rating from the NRF.
