



Prof Van der Vyver is Buitengewone Professor in die Departement Privaatreg in die Fakulteit Regsgeleerdheid. Hy is sedert 1995 die I T Cohen Professor in Internasionale Reg en Menseregte in die Skool vir Regsgeleerdheid van die Emory Universiteit in Atlanta, Georgia in die VSA. Sy huidige doseerverpligtinge sluit Internasionale Publiekreg, Internasionale Menseregte, Internasionale Strafreë, Internasionale Humanitêre Reg en Vergelykende Grondwetlike Reg in. Sy akademiese kwalifikasies sluit 'n Doktorsgraad in Regsgeleerdheid van die Universiteit van Pretoria (1974), 'n Doktorsgraad in Regsgeleerdheid (*honoris causa*) van die Universiteit van Zululand (1993), en een van die voormalige Potchefstroomse Universiteit (2003) in, asook die Diploma in Internasionale en Vergelykende Reg van Menseregte van die Internasionale Instituut vir Menseregte in Strasbourg, Frankryk (1986).

Hy is die outeur van agt boeke en meer as 200 regsorsigartikels, hoofstukke in boeke, en boekresensies. Sy mees onlangse publikasies sluit in *Leuven Lectures on Religious Institutions, Religious Communities and Rights* (Uitgeverij Peters, 2004) en *Implementation of International Law in the United States* (Peter Lang, 2010). Hy was nou betrokke by die verrigtinge wat gelei het tot die stigting van die Internasionale Strafhof en het aktief gebly as lid van die nieregeringsorganisasie Coalition for the International Criminal Court in verrigtinge van die Assembly of States' Parties of the Court.

Prof Van der Vyver het al in baie lande aan konferensies deelgeneem en het in die afgelope aantal jare klas- en somerskoollesings in Duitsland, Frankryk en Oostenryk aangebied. Sedert 2010 het hy ook deelgeneem aan 'n lesingreeks oor *Religious Freedom and the Rule of Law* aan die Saigon Universiteit in Beijing, China. Hy het 'n A2-gradering van die NNS.

Prof Van der Vyver is an Extraordinary Professor in the Department of Private Law in the Faculty of Law. He has been the I T Cohen Professor of International Law and Human Rights in the School of Law of Emory University in Atlanta Georgia, USA since 1995. His current teaching obligations include Public International Law, International Human Rights, International Criminal Law, International Humanitarian Law, and Comparative Constitutional Law. His academic qualifications include a Doctor of Laws degree from the University of Pretoria (1974), a Doctor of Laws degree (*honoris causa*) from the University of Zululand (1993), and one from the former Potchefstroom University (2003), as well as the Diploma of the International and Comparative Law of Human Rights of the International Institute of Human Rights in Strasbourg, France (1986).

He is the author of eight books and more than 200 law review articles, chapters in books, and book reviews. His most recent publications include *Leuven Lectures on Religious Institutions, Religious Communities and Rights* (Uitgeverij Peters, 2004) and *Implementation of International Law in the United States* (Peter Lang, 2010). He was intimately involved in proceedings that culminated in the establishment of the International Criminal Court and has remained active as a member of the non-governmental organisation, Coalition for the International Criminal Court in proceedings of the Assembly of States' Parties of the Court.

Prof Van der Vyver has participated in conferences in many countries and has over the past few years delivered in-class and summer school lectures in Germany, France and Austria. Since 2010, he has also participated in a lecture series on *Religious Freedom and the Rule of Law* at Saigon University in Beijing in China. He has an A2-rating from the NRF.
