

Are you looking to advance your career prospects, take your professional skills to a higher level or pursue your passion for learning or research?

LLD students are invited to apply for a full time funding at UP.

(This bursary opportunity is only available to admitted and/or registered doctoral students at the Faculty of Law, University of Pretoria.)

Full time bursary*

This is a *full-time* programme and students are expected to complete their studies within <u>three years</u>. Students in this programme serve as research assistants and tutors and are required to work for up to ten hours per week in the department in which they are registered. They also participate in research discussions where they present their work. They are required to publish three articles. Students may therefore not have other employment for the duration of their studies. Continuation of their funding from year to year will depend on satisfactory progress.

The funding provided by the University of Pretoria, if available, may assist to cover accommodation, and a monthly stipend. Single students only will be catered for. Funding is not provided for families.

Admission

Admission takes place according to a selection process based *inter alia* on the candidate's academic record, experience, and the merit of the research topic. A Master's degree in law is a pre-requisite.

Study duration

LLD studies must be completed in a minimum of two years and a maximum of four years.

Funding duration

Funding will be provided for a maximum of three years, however date of first registration will be taken into consideration. Therefore if you will be in your second or third year of registration in 2014 you will only be funded up until the regulated four years allocated for the completion of the LLD degree.

Closing date for applications

31 July 2013 for registration and funding in January 2014

Application procedure

We will require a motivational letter approved by your supervisor detailing the following information:

- why you wish to be considered for full time funding
- a proposed time line of how you will complete within the allotted time of the programme
- current progress made with regards to your chosen field of research (applicable only to registered students)

Please insure that you provide your full name and student number in your motivation. Late applications will not be considered.
